**Course Descriptions**

**Morning Classes**

**3012 People of Color in the Bible, Part III**

**Dr. Tonnie Bradford**

The course is designed to identify those nations and personalities in the Bible who were people of color. Students will examine the contributions made by these individuals and groups.

**5020 Conflict Management**

**Rev. Dr. John K. Coar**

This course will examine basic Biblical principles that students may apply to successfully maneuver through various conflicts that frequently arise in the church and develop a model that can be used in conflict resolution.

**7008 Reaching the Un-churched, Part II**

**Rev. Dr. Linden Bowie**

This course will teach strategies to reach un-churched people and identify the reasons why people leave church. Using the model of Jesus and the apostles, it will share the biblical principle of belonging to a fellowship of believers with a spirit of restoration.

**9024 Artificial Intelligence in the Church**

**Dr. Serena Rowan**

Explores how emerging AI tools can be thoughtfully, ethically, and faithfully integrated into Christian ministry. Equips church leaders with practical ways AI can support teaching, administration, discipleship, pastoral care, and community engagement. Hands-on demonstrations-- responsible use of technology for God's purposes.

**Evening Classes**

**1085 The Parables of Jesus**

**Rev. Keith Pendleton**

This course will focus on the various parables that Jesus used in His teaching ministry. Students will focus on the heavenly meaning of these earthly stories. This focus will be on the background and message of each parable.

**2079 Music in Christian Education**

**Sis. Sherry Jones**

This course will explore the use of music as an integral part of the Christian Education program. Students will identify the various types of music used in Christian Education, including hymns, anthems, gospels and others.

**2091 Women in the Bible, Part II**

This course will examine some of the issues women in the Bible days faced, which are remarkably similar to those faced today. The same Lord who healed and helped them is available to us today.

**5012 Becoming an Effective Deacon**
